The Chairman can invite any other expert(s) depending on the need of the Committee, to the meetings.


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The terms of reference for the expert committee are:

- i. To recommend standards for RDF to be used in cement kilns and RDF based Waste to Energy Plants.
- ii. To recommend the non-technological innovations needed (e.g. Government policies, fiscal incentives, system delivery innovations, social innovations) for RDF usage to be practiced on an affordable, sustainable and scalable basis.
- iii. Any other matter related to the subject.

Committee will hold three to four meetings in all over a period of three months to complete the report within 90 days of constitution of the committee. Ministry can extend the term, if required.

The TA, DA, sitting fees, boarding and lodging of the members of the Expert Committee will be borne out of SBM Capacity Building Fund held at the Central level by the Ministry and administered by the SBM Division. The air ticket shall be economy class booked on Air India on their website only. The sitting fee will be regulated as per Dept. of Expenditure's OM No. 19047/10/2016-E.IV dated 12.4.2017.
